

THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

Today we hear how Abram encounters Melchizedek, "king of Salem . . . and a priest of God Most High" (Genesis 14:18). Melchizedek appears nowhere else in scripture, but is nonetheless significant. Psalm 110 declares of the great King David, "You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek," a description later given (in the letter to the Hebrews) to Christ as High Priest. Early Christians saw in Melchizedek's bread and wine the bread and wine of the Eucharist; Paul's account of the Last Supper (in today's second reading) is the oldest one in scripture. In the Gospel, Luke describes Jesus providing bread for a crowd in words similar to Paul's, words still used by the Church: Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it. Together, these three readings reveal how Christian priesthood, Christ's Real Presence, and the call to serve those in need are all found in the gift of the Eucharist.

VOLUNTEER CLEARANCES: AS EASY AS 1, 2, 3, ...

The process for renewal of clearances is easier than you think. Anyone who had clearances before won't have to view the entire Virtus presentation, and won't have to take Mandated Reporter again. These are "one and done." Only four simple items are needed: (1) State Police Criminal (done online, instantaneously, free), (2) State Child Abuse (free), (3) the Affidavit (fingerprinting workaround) which only needs to be notarized, and (4) a brief Virtus refresher, which is online, free, and takes less than 30 minutes.
