Flowers that Feed the Soul: Our Ministry Listing

- Greeters Welcome people as they enter the church, and Religious Formation Volunteers/Youth Ministry assist those with baby carriers, wheelchairs, and walkers.
- Ushers Take up the offertory and distribute bulletins after Mass. They also assist as needed with emergencies or other necessary concerns.
- Lectors Proclaim the word of God during Mass or other liturgical functions. Lectors devote time to preparation and understanding of sacred Scripture.
- Altar Servers Assist the priest in preparing for Mass. The servers take part in the liturgy by performing tasks to help the priest celebrate Eucharist. Children who received their first holy Communion can be altar servers
- Music Ministry Choirs and cantors provide musical support of full and active participation in the liturgy.
- Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist Assist the priest by distributing the Eucharist at Mass.
- Money Counters Assist in counting the Sunday and Holy Day collections according to established guidelines
